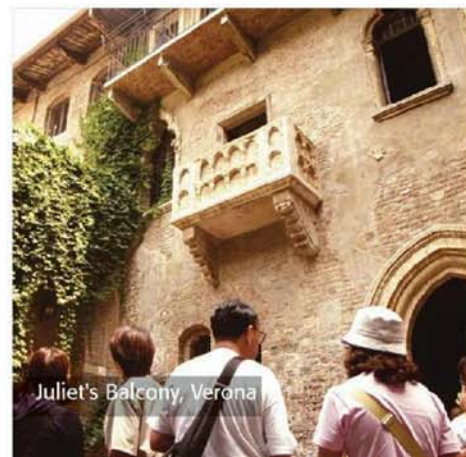

DAY 5 SORRENTO EXCURSION

Your excursion to the nearby resort of Sorrento starts with a visit to an inlaid wood workshop, for which the area is renowned. Later, consider an optional visit to the enchanting Isle of Capri, former summer residence of Roman emperors and still popular with the rich and famous. Dine this evening at your hotel. (BB D)

DAY 6 BAY OF NAPLES – ASSISI

Drive into the rolling hills of Umbria to the mystical town of Assisi on the slopes of Mount Subasio, birthplace of St. Francis. Your Travel Director gives you an orientation tour, which includes St. Francis' Basilica, renowned for its fresco paintings. (BB D) Hotel: Frate Sole (MF)

DAY 7 ASSISI – VENICE (2 NIGHTS)

Enjoy a scenic drive across the dramatic Apennine Mountains to the magical floating city of Venice. (BB D) Hotel: Il Burchiello (Oriago) (F)

DAY 8 VENICE ORIENTATION AND FREE TIME
